An average of 88% will continue to practice in rural communities after their term of service has ended.</p>	 <p>8.4 million Expands funding for community health centers, where 8.4 million rural Americans get access to primary and preventive care.</p>	 <p>Tax credits and affordable insurance options to help rural families get covered, even if they are self-employed. 7 out of 10 Americans have found coverage for less than a \$75 a month.</p>	<p>\$7.5 billion+</p> <p>USDA has also invested more than 7.5 billion since 2009 to build rural hospitals and clinics and support telemedicine services for remote rural areas.</p>
